A Brief History of Kennedy Park Resort Napier

Kennedy Park was named after Charles Kennedy, a Hawke's Bay Pioneer eminent in the Professions, Sport and Horticulture. Mr Kennedy's career ranged from Law to Civil Engineering. Charles Kennedy's house stood in the grounds where Kennedy Park is now. He sold his home in 1922, but it was later damaged in the earthquake of 1931 and moved to another site.

Kennedy Park began in 1937 when the then Napier Borough Council was persuaded of the need for a Motor Camp and three acres were leased from the Harbour Board for this purpose. After various legalities, extra land was acquired and an area of approximately 17 ½ acres was vested in the Council. At the beginning, the area was run solely as a Motor Camp and consisted of camp sites, huts and caravan sites. It also included the adjacent Rose Garden.

During the war years the park was used by the army, who left behind several large army huts when the camp was vacated. During the postwar years these were used to provide transit accommodation for families awaiting permanent housing - the last family vacated the huts in

1957. The Council was then faced with the decision of what to do with the buildings.

At this time there was a shortage of holiday accommodation in Napier, so the Council converted the empty huts into self contained units. The demand was so great that in 1960 the council decided to erect more Motel units. A further eight were built out of the camps revenue. The two storey curved building opened in 1980. There were no new buildings until 1998 after management was assumed by Tourism Services Limited. The Park reverted to full Council control in 2003.

Kennedy Park now consists of Conference Facilities, 15 Villas, 24 Motel Units, 24 Holiday Units, 10 Deluxe Ensuite Units, 8 Ensuite Units, 6 Kitchen Cabins, 4 Standard Cabins and 170 Camping Sites.

And so began the legacy of Kennedy Park.





Emergency Procedures

In the event of a fire or other emergency.

FIRE

- ° Warn everyone of Fire
- Get out of the building and go to the assembly area, the grass area in front of the two storey building
- o Dial 111 from a safe place
- ° Advise Reception or Duty Manager <u>as soon as possible</u>

EARTHQUAKE

If you are inside a building, move no more than a few steps, drop, cover and hold.

° Stay indoors until the shaking stops and you are sure it



is safe to exit. In most buildings in New Zealand you are safer if you stay where you are until the shaking stops.

° Keep away from all glass and windows.

 Once the earthquake has stopped and it is safe to move, go outside to the assembly area, the grass area, in front of the two storey building.

If you are outdoors when the shaking starts,

- Move no more than a few steps away from buildings, trees, streetlights, and power lines, then Drop, Cover and Hold.
- Once earthquake has stopped and it is safe to move, go to the assembly area, the grass area, in front of two storey building.

TSUNAMI

Long and Strong Get Gone

Our evacuation point in the event of a Tsunami is Sugar Loaf in Taradale.

ALCOHOL

Should you wish to consume alcohol on site, please do so in the confines of your unit or camp-site, without disturbing other guests. Alcohol is not permitted around the grounds or in communal buildings.

BBQ'S

We have four FREE BBQ's stationed in our BBQ area, behind the main ablution block. Alternatively you can have one delivered to your unit for \$27.00 for a maximum of two hours.

BICYCLE HIRE

We have a variety of bicycles for hire. This includes tandem bicycles, kid's bicycles and bicycles with a child seat attached. Please see Reception for details.

BREAKFASTS

If you wish to order a Continental Breakfast at \$12.00 per person, please fill in a form at Reception before 7.00pm. Trays will be delivered to your unit the evening before the Breakfast is required.

CAFÉ

Espresso Coffee is available at our on-site café from December through to February and selected weekends throughout the year.

For further information please see reception or from your unit dial 750 for Café hours.

CAR WASH

We have a Vehicle Cleaning Area positioned in front of the two-storey Holiday Unit building, opposite Unit 31. A bucket, wash liquid, brush and chamois can be collected from the office. A bond of \$10.00 is required.



CHILLER KEYS

We have a chiller located opposite the ablution block for those who wish to have goods chilled and stored securely. A \$20 bond is required along with a \$1.50 a day hire fee. Please see reception for a key.

CLOTHES LINES

We have 2 clothes lines located between unit 47 and the Ablution block - You will need your own pegs.

COMPLAINTS/DISTURBANCES

Please notify Reception of any problems or disturbances by dialing 0 from your unit's phone or ringing 06 843 9126 from a mobile.

COOKWARE BUCKET

We have a cookware container available in reception. This container includes: 1 frying pan, 1 oven dish, 4 dinner plates, 4 bowls, 4 mugs, 4 side plates, 1 small pot, 1 large pot, 1 whisk, 1 dish cloth, 1 dish brush, 1 can opener, 1 peeler, 1 fish slice, 1 sharp knife, 1 tongs, 5 forks, 5 knives, 4 spoons, 4 teaspoons, 1 tea towel and 2 detergent. A \$20.00 bond is required.

DEPARTURE

Checkout time is 10:00am (please be prompt). Late departures can only be arranged at off-peak times through Reception. Additional charges may apply.

DRY-CLEANING

A Pick-up service is available at Reception. Same day drycleaning must be notified by 8.00 am. It will be returned by 4:00pm

DVD PLAYER

If you do not have a DVD player in your room, you may hire

one from reception. We also have a DVD library available from reception. DVD player hire is \$11.00 per night, DVD movies \$4.00 per night.

FIRST AID KIT

FIRES/FIREWORKS

Open fires or Fireworks are **not** permitted. **No Exceptions**.

HEATED POOL

We have 1 heated pool that is approximately 1 meter deep and 15 metres long, along with a heated toddler's pool to enjoy in the cooler winter days, with an additional beach pool for those hot summer days. This is open between 7.30am and 9pm. Your grey/black key tag or passcode will give you access to this facility.

HIGH CHAIRS

High Chairs are available for hire from Reception at \$6.00 per day/night.

HOLIDAY ACTIVITIES

We run holiday activities daily during the Christmas Holiday period for the kids. There are two sessions per day, charged at \$2.00 per child per session, with programs available from Reception. Please register at reception by 9.00am each day.

LAUNDRY

There are three laundries available. 2 x \$2 coins are

required for the washing machines. Dryers accept both \$1 and \$2 coins. Two laundries are situated in the Main Ablution Block behind the Kitchen. Another is located in the Amenity Block beside the Swimming Pool. Washing powder is included in the cost of the washing machine and is added automatically to your wash.

MESSAGES/MAIL

MOTEL/VILLA LAUNDRY

Washing machines and dryers are located behind the Restaurant, among the Studio Motels. Washing powder is available for purchase at Reception. This Laundry is for Motel and Villa guests only.

NOISE/DISTURBANCE

Kennedy Park has a strict noise control policy between the hours of 10.00pm and 7.30am. Please be thoughtful to other guests in the park. Management reserves the right to cancel tenancy at any time should there be, in the opinion of Management, objectionable manner or disregard of the Park Rules and there will be no refund of fees paid. Please notify reception by dialling 0 if you are being disturbed.

PEDAL CARS

Pedal Cars are available for hire within the grounds. They can be hired from Reception at \$10.00 per hour. Caregivers are required to come to Reception to sign their permission and fill out the required form.



PETS

Pets are not permitted inside units or within Kennedy Park grounds.

PORT A COT

Port a Cot's are available for hire from Reception at \$6.00 per night.

PUBLIC PHONES

Coin, card and credit card phones are located onsite on Main Street, opposite the Games/TV Room. Phone cards are available for purchase from Reception.

RECEPTION

Reception facilities are available 24 hours. We accept Eftpos and all Major Credit Cards.

RECREATIONAL

Basketball/Rugby Ball/Soccer Ball/Volley Ball/Badminton Set, PLUS a selection of Board Games are available from Reception. A \$10.00 Bond is required, refundable on return of the hired item in a satisfactory state.

RECYCLING

To conserve resources, Recycling Depots are located within Kennedy Park. Please place recyclable waste in the three types of bins provided. You will find a Recycle Bin in your room to place recyclable items and transport them to the Recycling Depots. Non recyclable waste may be placed in the Kitchen bin and in the containers at the Recycling Depots.

SECURITY

Please make sure all valuables are secured. Lock your unit and car doors. Kindly DO NOT leave any personal belongings in your car or outside your unit or tent unsecured. A safe is available in Reception for any valuable items. When bringing your bicycles into the Park, please ensure they are secured when not in use, especially at night. We have a lockable shed on site where bicycles can be safely stored.

SMOKING

Kennedy Park has a strict **no smoking** policy (including vaping). This means no smoking anywhere on the grounds except in the designated smoking area located in the front car park.

TAKEAWAY DELIVERIES

TRAFFIC

Vehicles must travel at walking pace, 10k's per hour, at all times within the Park. This includes bicycles, scooters, skateboards and roller skates. Caregivers are expected to ensure children are aware of traffic movement within the Park and to ensure they operate scooters, bikes, etc in a safe and considerate manner. No bicycles, scooters, roller blades/skates, or skateboards are permitted to be used through the wooden walk way outside the Games/ TV Room.

Drivers – please be aware that children may run out in front of your vehicle.
